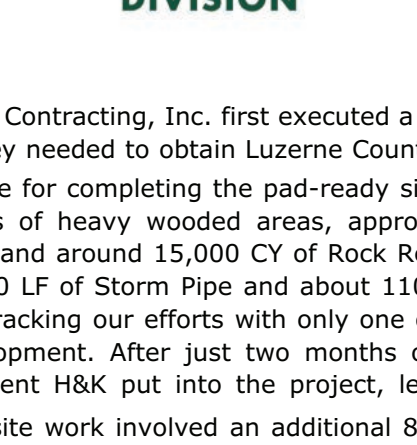

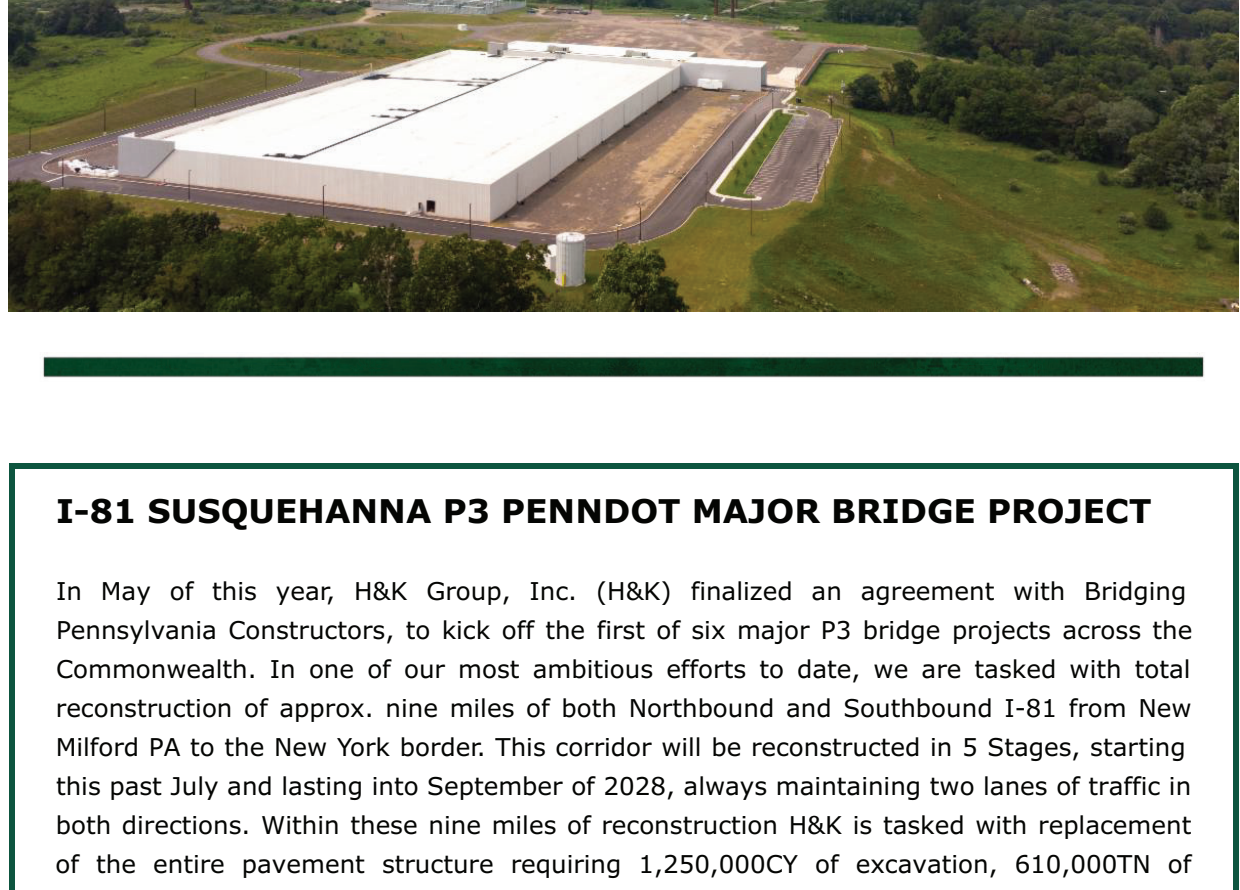


REGIONAL CONTRACTING SPOTLIGHT



In mid-June of 2021, when HITT Contracting, Inc. first executed a Notice of Intent to award a pad-ready site for Cumulus Data, they needed to obtain Luzerne County Conservation District approval to commence work. The deadline for completing the pad-ready site was set for August 12th. The task involved clearing 10 Acres of heavy wooded areas, approximately 300,000 CY of topsoil stripping and site cuts and fills, and around 15,000 CY of Rock Removal. Additionally, the project included the installation of 6,400 LF of Storm Pipe and about 110 Precast Structures. We quickly embarked on the project, fast-tracking our efforts with only one eye in sight: to secure the next phases of the 1600-acre development. After just two months on-site, both the client and the owner recognized the commitment H&K put into the project, leading to the subsequent phase being awarded. The remaining site work involved an additional 80,000 cubic yards of earthwork, encompassing all underground utilities. This included 6,500 linear feet of sanitary sewer, featuring a low-pressure system with four pump stations, and 11,000 feet of waterline ranging from 2-inch HDPE to 12-inch Ductile iron pipe. The project also entailed installing 206,000 linear feet of 4-inch conduit encased in concrete, PennDOT driveway entrance upgrades, and the application of 12,000 tons of asphalt along with 20,000 tons of stone subbase.

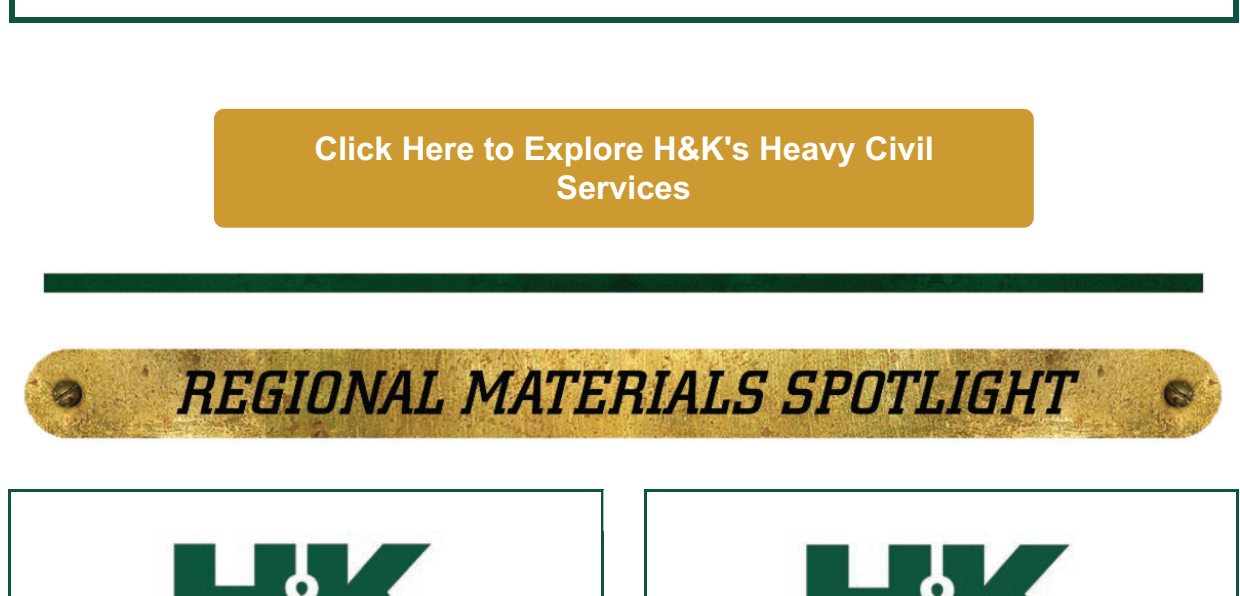
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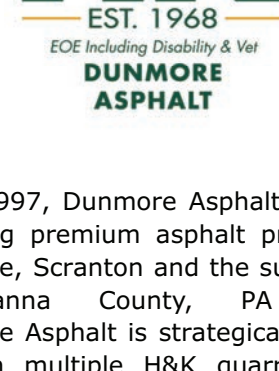
I-81 SUSQUEHANNA P3 PENNDOT MAJOR BRIDGE PROJECT

In May of this year, H&K Group, Inc. (H&K) finalized an agreement with Bridging Pennsylvania Constructors, to kick off the first of six major P3 bridge projects across the Commonwealth. In one of our most ambitious efforts to date, we are tasked with total reconstruction of approx. nine miles of both Northbound and Southbound I-81 from Millford PA to the New York border. This corridor will be reconstructed in 5 Stages, starting this past July and lasting into September of 2028, always maintaining two lanes of traffic in both directions. Within these nine miles of reconstruction H&K is tasked with replacement of the entire pavement structure requiring 1,250,000CY of excavation, 610,000TN of aggregate, and 650,000TN of asphalt. The existing storm sewer system is replaced with the installation of 42,000LF of 100 Year RCP and 620 precast inlet structures. Our partners will also be tasked with full replacement of guiderail, barrier, line striping, fencing, and signage.

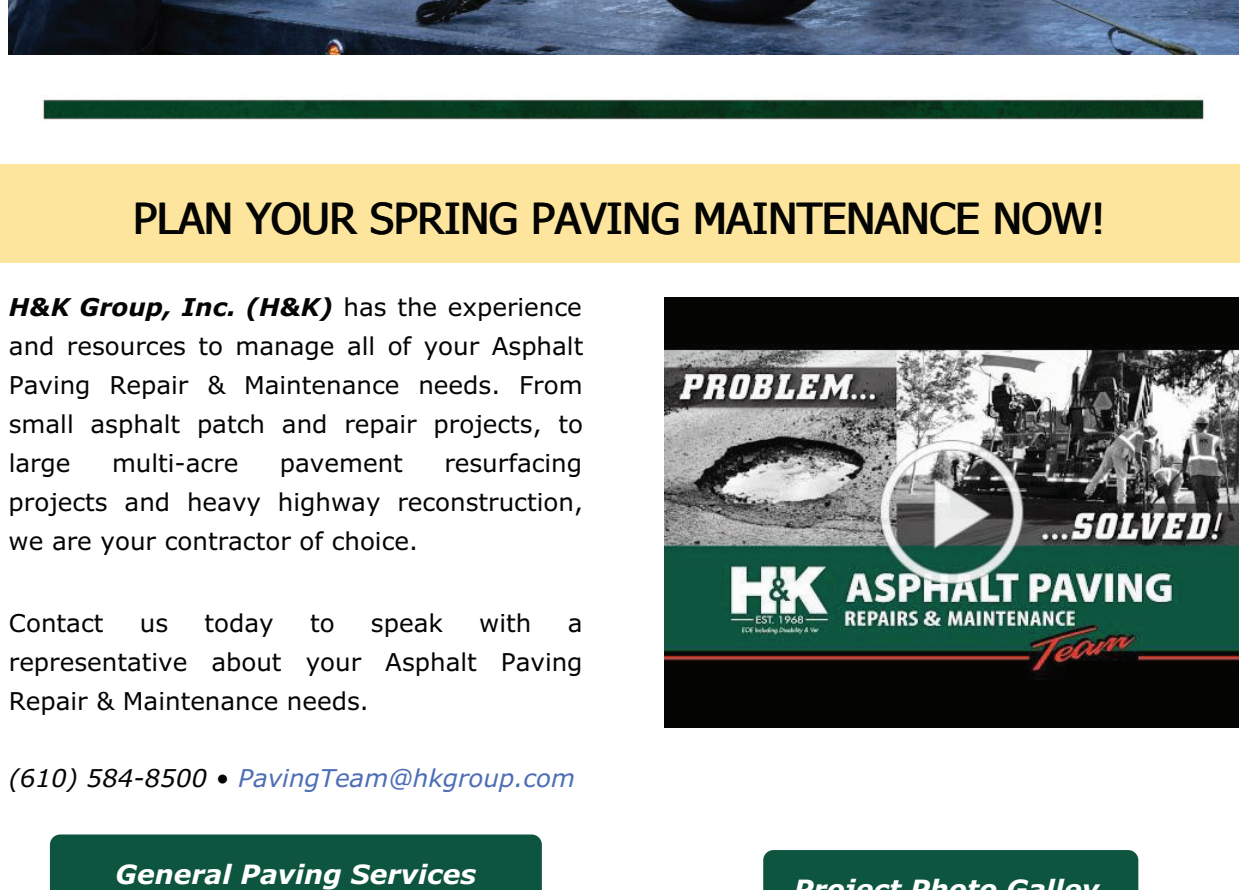
REGIONAL MAINTENANCE SPOTLIGHT

H&K Group, Inc., (H&K) partnered with Rahns Construction Material Co. (Rahns Concrete) to supply an operating diesel engine and transmission to Western Montgomery Career and Technology Center in Royersford, PA.

The engine, a Caterpillar C10, and the transmission, an Allison automatic, were gone over, painted and "put together" on a frame with a fuel tank, battery box and all other essentials needed to make the engine function as it normally would. The setup will be used to test students on diagnostics in the diesel technology program.

Rahns Concrete's lead mechanic assembled the engine and transmission setup, H&K's in-house weld shop provided fabrication assistance, H&K's Austin Auto Body affiliate painted the components and H&K's Austin Graphics affiliate provided lettering on the control panel. Dunne's Towing was gracious enough to transport the engine to the Career Center.

Employees from H&K and Rahns were on hand to present the engine to the Career Center on Thursday, December 14th, 2023.

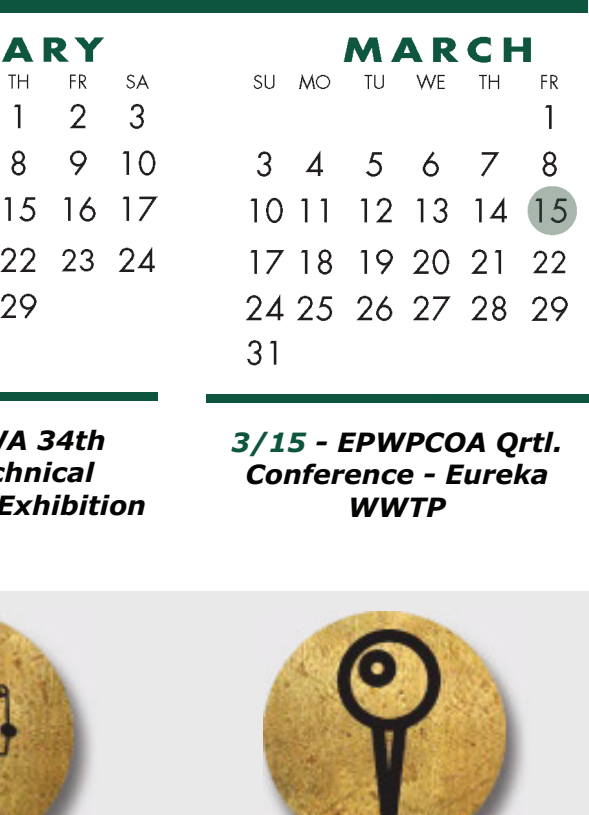

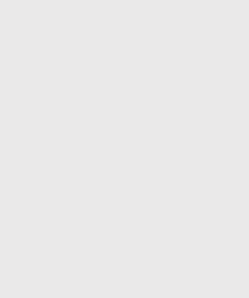

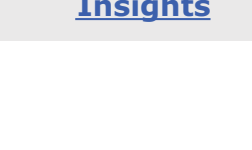
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
